<p>6. Director's Report</p>	<p>Delilah Perez</p>	<p>Delilah Perez introduced Victoria County Public Health Department staff - Melody Stanford and Angie Stafford.</p> <p>1. Melody Stanford - Environmental Department addressed the board. Melody Stanford outlined the various duties of the Environmental Department provides services for 4 counties, Victoria, Calhoun, DeWitt and Jackson. The Environmental Department's primary duties are Food Inspection, Septic Installation Inspection, Storm Water Inspection, Floodplain, Water Lab and Mosquito Spraying. Delilah Perez added that the Environmental Department currently has 9 Sanitary Inspectors. We received a grant that allowed the increase of 2 Inspectors.</p> <p>2. Angie Stafford - Texas Home Visiting informed the Board of the programs included in Texas Home Visiting. Parents as Teachers and Family Connects. Family Connects provides at home nurse visit to determine weight of the baby, health of the mother, feeding preference, postpartum depression, management of infant crying, safe sleeping, back to work support, childcare options and having a healthy home. Parents as Teachers provided home visitation that offer personalized parent-child activities, developmental screening, group connections and community resources. Angie Stafford also added that they currently offer car seat installation and inspection. The main lobby of the Health Department is now home to a mini library that allows children to take a book</p>	

		home. Books are donated and restocked regularly.
